The following is a copy of an email I received from Lisa Cowell from UWA on 14 May 2012. Normally the STAT is not available to school aged students, but the university will write a letter, which will enable your child to sit the test on application.

Please remember your child will still need to complete the pre-requisite subjects to enter a particular course.

Dear Stuart

Further to our earlier telephone conversation, students who have been home-schooled, or who have completed their schooling outside the mainstream education system are considered for entry on the basis of:

- presentation of a portfolio, giving an accurate representation of their study program in the year prior to application;
- completion of the Multiple Choice and Written English sections of the Special Tertiary Admissions Test (administered by the [Tertiary Institute Service Centre or TISC](#));

• completion of any other tests required to meet prerequisite requirements. Selection is based on satisfactory performance in the Special Tertiary Admissions Test.
