Baby Horned Owls Are Hungry

The mother horned owl stays on her nest. The father owl brings her food. About 28 days after she lays the eggs, the first owlet hatches. Two days later a second owlet is born. Two days later the third owlet is born.

The owlets can't get enough to eat. The father owl flies away to hunt meals for the hungry owlets. The mother owl stays on the nest and prepares the food that the father owl brings for the owlets. She makes the food small enough for the hungry owlets to eat.



Owls eat small animals. When there are too many small animals, the owls help get rid of them. When there are not many small animals, the mother owl lays fewer eggs, and fewer owlets live to eat the small animals.

God made the horned owls to help us. He made owls to keep us from having too many small animals.

Horned owls do most of their hunting at night. A horned owl needs to see well at night. It needs to hunt food for its hungry owlets.

The Owl Can See Well



The horned owl needs to hunt at night. God gave it special eyes so it could see at night. The horned owl's eyes change shape in the dark. The horned owl also has three eyelids. The third eyelid keeps the eye of the owl clear and wet as it flies at night. This eyelid keeps the

owl's eye from being hurt when it flies.

The owl cannot move its eyes from side to side or up and down. Instead, it moves its head. The owl can move its head half way around in either direction. God gave the owl special eyes for hunting.
