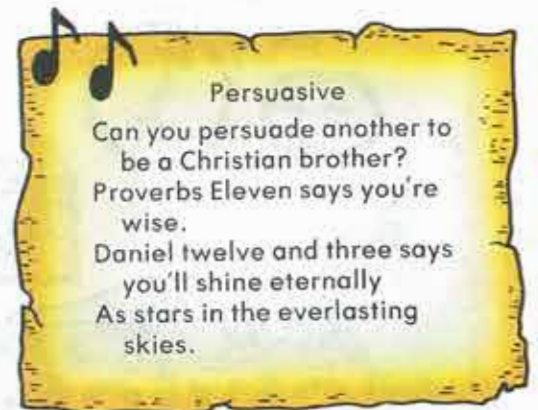
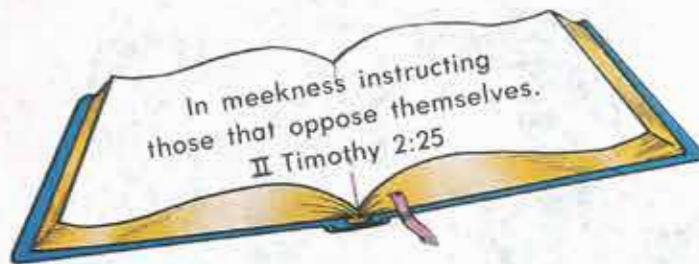

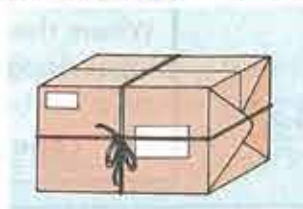


Order means the rule of authority or law.

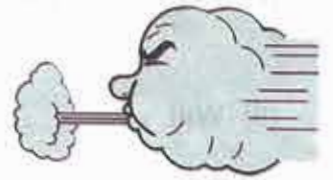
